# Unity, Diversity, and Humility in the Body

## Today's Verses

I Corinthians 12:22-30, Romans 12:3, Philippians 2:1-11, John 3:30

## Verse of the Week

<sup>22</sup>“On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable,  
<sup>23</sup>and the parts that we think are less honorable, we treat with special honor.”

~ I Corinthians 12:22-23

### 1. We are all part of the same body.

- *I Corinthians 12:12-14* – “Just as one body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body – whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free – and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. Even so the body is not made of one part but of many.”

### 2. We are all different – praise God for our diversity.

- *I Corinthians 12:15-20* – “Now if the foot should say, ‘Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body,’ it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. And if the ear should say, ‘Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body,’ it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? But in fact, God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. If there all one part, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, but one body.”

### 3. We are all indispensable in God's plan.

- *I Corinthians 12:21- 22,24-26* – “The eye cannot say to the hand, ‘I don't need you!’ And the head cannot say to the feet, ‘I don't need you!’ On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable... But God has put the body together, giving greater honor to the parts that lacked it so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it.”

### 4. We should all clothes ourselves in humility and appreciate the contribution of others. Only Jesus is truly indispensable. Never get puffed up as if the world couldn't get along without us.

- *I Corinthians 12:22-23* – “On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and the parts that we think are less honorable, we treat with special honor.”
- *Romans 12:3* – “For by the grace given me, I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you.”
- *Philippians 2:3-4* – “Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility, value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.” (The humility of Christ is our best example.)
- *John 3:30* – John the Baptist – “He must become greater; I must become less.”

### 5. Our roles are all important but without each other our roles are meaningless.

- *I Corinthians 12:27-30* – “Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is part of it. And God has placed in the church, first of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healing, of helping, of guidance, and of different kinds of tongues. Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work miracles? Do all have gifts of healing? Do all speak in tongues? Do all interpret? Now eagerly desire the greater gifts.”

### Versos del Dia

I Corintios 12:22-30, Romanos 12:3, Filipenses 2:1-11, Juan 3:30

### Verso de la Semana

<sup>22</sup> Al contrario, los miembros del cuerpo que parecen más débiles son indispensables,  
<sup>23</sup> y a los que nos parecen menos honrosos los tratamos con honra especial. Y se les trata con especial modestia a los miembros que nos parecen menos presentables.”

~ I Corintios 12:22-23

#### 1 Todos somos parte del mismo cuerpo.

- *I Corintios 12:12-14* – “De hecho, aunque el cuerpo es uno solo, tiene muchos miembros, y todos los miembros, no obstante ser muchos, forman un solo cuerpo. Así sucede con Cristo. Todos fuimos bautizados por un solo Espíritu para constituir un solo cuerpo —ya seamos judíos o gentiles, esclavos o libres—, y a todos se nos dio a beber de un mismo Espíritu. Ahora bien, el cuerpo no consta de un solo miembro, sino de muchos.”

#### 2 Todos somos diferentes – alabar al Señor por nuestra diversidad.

- *I Corintios 12:15-20* – “Si el pie dijera: «Como no soy mano, no soy del cuerpo», no por eso dejaría de ser parte del cuerpo. Y, si la oreja dijera: «Como no soy ojo, no soy del cuerpo», no por eso dejaría de ser parte del cuerpo. Si todo el cuerpo fuera ojo, ¿qué sería del oído? Si todo el cuerpo fuera oído, ¿qué sería del olfato? En realidad, Dios colocó cada miembro del cuerpo como mejor le pareció. Si todos ellos fueran un solo miembro, ¿qué sería del cuerpo? Lo cierto es que hay muchos miembros, pero el cuerpo es uno solo.”

#### 3 Todos somos indispensables en el plan de Dios.

- *I Corintios 12:21- 22,24-26* – “El ojo no puede decirle a la mano: «No te necesito». Ni puede la cabeza decirles a los pies: «No los necesito». Al contrario, los miembros del cuerpo que parecen más débiles son indispensables... Así Dios ha dispuesto los miembros de nuestro cuerpo, dando mayor honra a los que menos tenían, a fin de que no haya división en el cuerpo, sino que sus miembros se preocupen por igual unos por otros. Si uno de los miembros sufre, los demás comparten su sufrimiento; y, si uno de ellos recibe honor, los demás se alegran con él.”

#### 4 Debemos de vestirnos en humildad y apreciar la contribucion de los demas. Solo Jesus es realmente indispensable. Nunca te agrandes como si el mundo no pudiera llevarse bien con nosotros.

- *I Corintios 12:22-23* – “Al contrario, los miembros del cuerpo que parecen más débiles son indispensables, y a los que nos parecen menos honrosos los tratamos con honra especial. Y se les trata con especial modestia a los miembros que nos parecen menos presentables.”
- *Romanos 12:3* – “Por la gracia que se me ha dado, les digo a todos ustedes: Nadie tenga un concepto de sí más alto que el que debe tener, sino más bien piense de sí mismo con moderación, según la medida de fe que Dios le haya dado.”
- *Filipenses 2:3-4* – “No hagan nada por egoísmo o vanidad; más bien, con humildad consideren a los demás como superiores a ustedes mismos. Cada uno debe velar no solo por sus propios intereses, sino también por los intereses de los demás. (La humildad de Cristo es nuestro mayor ejemplo.)
- Juan 3:30 – Juan el Bautista – “A él le toca crecer, y a mí menguar.”

#### 5 Nuestro rol es importante pero sin los demas nuestro rol es insignificativo.

- *I Corintios 12:27-30* – “Ahora bien, ustedes son el cuerpo de Cristo, y cada uno es miembro de ese cuerpo. En la iglesia Dios ha puesto, en primer lugar, apóstoles; en segundo lugar, profetas; en tercer lugar, maestros; luego los que hacen milagros; después los que tienen dones para sanar enfermos, los que ayudan a otros, los que administran y los que hablan en diversas lenguas. ¿Son todos apóstoles? ¿Son todos profetas? ¿Son todos maestros? ¿Hacen todos Milagros? ¿Tienen todos dones para sanar enfermos? ¿Hablan todos en lenguas? ¿Acaso interpretan todos?”
